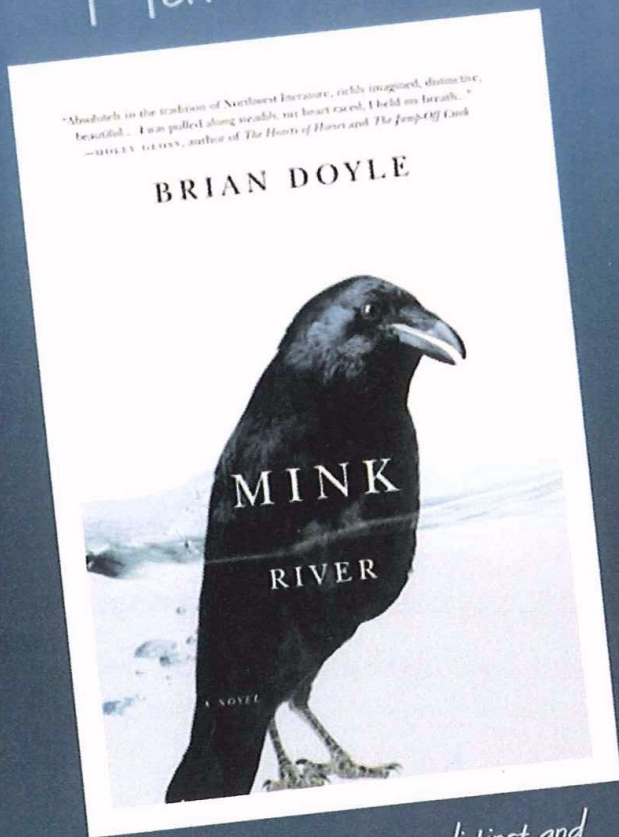


# Jefferson County Community Read 2012
